

SECURITY CHECKLIST

YES NO Considerations

Are your exterior doors made of a solid material, (such as wood or uPVC) and secured with a british standard lock?

You should consider upgrading your locks to British Standard. If you have a wooden door more than 44mm thick, a 5-lever mortice lock is best.

Does your door have a chain or a similar device?

Door chains are a great way to add extra security to your front door, they can help prevent the entry of unwanted guests.

Do you have locks on all of your windows?

Windows are a prime target for burglars. If every window does not have a lock, then consider installing a key operated window lock.

Is your garden accessible over a wall or fence?

Prikka Strips fit easily to the top of walls and are a perfect deterrent for walls being climbed over.

Are any of your lights fitted with timers?

Putting lights on timers is an easy way to make your home look occupied whilst you're out for the evening.

Does your garden have bushes, shrubs or dark areas?

Can access be gained through your letterbox?

Letter box guards are a great way of stopping intruders from gaining entry through a letterbox.

Do you keep a spare key under your mat?

This is one of the first places a potential intruder will look. You should consider getting a key safe fitted to the exterior of your home.
